PLEASE NOTE:

- Parish regulations require that current Church Stewardship minimum commitment of
 \$750 to be paid <u>BEFORE</u> the Baptism for both parent and godparent.
- 2. The Archdiocese requires that when the godparent is not a member of another Parish where the Baptism is to take place, a letter of good ecclesiastical standing from his/her Parish must be presented to the officiating priest before the Baptism.
- 3. The Birth Certificate of the child to be baptized must be presented to the officiating priest before the ceremony. It will be returned immediately.
- 4. Godparent must be of the Orthodox Faith.

HOLY ORTHODOX BAPTISMAL & CHRISMATION RULES

Before the Baptism takes place and so that any misunderstanding may be avoided, here are some rules that our Holy Orthodox Christian Church has given us to follow:

- 1. The parent <u>must</u> be stewards of Ss. Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church in good standing financially. Family Church Stewardship minimum commitment of \$750 annually <u>must</u> be paid prior to the Baptism. Kindly clarify your status with the office in advance of the scheduled baptismal date.
- 2. The sponsor (Godparent) of a child baptized in the Orthodox Church must be involved in the life of the Church; if he/she is not a steward of Ss.

 Constantine and Helen, a letter from his/her parish must be submitted prior to the Baptism confirming that he/she is a steward in good standing and that there are no impediments concerning their spiritual status as Orthodox Christians; If married, must be married in the Church, and if divorced, must have been released from the Church through Spiritual Court. The sponsor must present a copy of the Ecclesiastical Marriage Certificate, or a copy of the Ecclesiastical Divorce. If the sponsor cannot provide the Certificate, he/she is not eligible to serve as a sponsor.
- 3. The sponsor must be over 12 years of age.
- 4. Orthodox Christians <u>may not</u> become sponsors at Baptisms/
 Confirmations in non-Orthodox churches (such as Roman Catholic, Episcopal,
 Lutheran, Baptist, etc.).

The following is a list of items which are needed on the day of the Baptism:

- 1. A Christening Outfit and a new change of clothes
- 2. White T-Shirt
- 3. Baptismal Cross
- 4. One Candle
- 5. One bar of hand soap
- 6. Two white hand towels
- 7. One large white bath towel
- 8. One white twin size sheet
- 9. One quart bottle of olive oil
